FC Helping Households Connect

The Affordable Connectivity Program is an FCC benefit program that helps ensure that households can afford the broadband they need for work, school, healthcare and more. The Emergency Broadband Benefit provides:

- Up to \$30/month discount for broadband service.
- Up to \$75/month discount for households on qualifying Tribal lands; and
- A one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet purchased through a participating provider if they contribute more than \$10 but less than \$50 toward the purchase price.

The Affordable Connectivity Program is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

Who is Eligible?

A household is eligible if a member of the household meets one of the criteria below:

- Has an income that is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines or
 participates in certain assistance programs, such as SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public
 Housing Assistance, Supplemental Security Insurance (SSI), WIC, Veterans Pension or
 Survivor Benefits, or Lifeline;
- Receives benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program;
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year;
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating broadband provider's existing lowincome program.

HOW TO APPLY:

Step 1. Go to <u>affordableconnectivity.gov</u> to apply online. Or you can call 877-384-2575 to discuss your eligibility or application status.

Step 2. Contact our office to let us know that you have a completed an application. We will need your assigned application id # at that time.
